BIBLE TEXT: **GENESIS 15:2**

God has a name.

It is to be respected.

Review: **ELOHIM:** the powerful creator God; One who keeps His covenant.

Today, we study another name of God: ADONAI

ADONAI

Adonai: a plural word

God is only ONE God: but He is made up of plurality – The Father, The Son, The Holy Spirit

Adonai: a name of God found in the Bible more than 400 times

ADONAI: Master or Ruler

It contains concepts of: dominion, rulership, ownership

Psalm 95:5 The sea is his, and he made it: and his hands formed the dry land

Psalm 50:10 For every beast of the forest is mine, and the cattle upon a thousand hills

God, in His role of Adonai fulfills all the responsibilities of ownership

Abraham saw Adonai through his hopeless situation

Bible text: Genesis 15:1-2

Verse 1: LORD (Jehovah)

Verse 2: Lord (Adonai)

Abraham is appealing to God's character as **Owner**

Genesis 15:8 – Abraham's hopeless situation

Genesis 15:18 - God makes a covenant with Abraham4

Adonai was teaching Abraham 2 truths that run through the Bible:

- 1. Adonai owns everything
- 2. We must obey Adonai

Moses saw Adonai through his hesitant service

Bible text: Exodus 4:10-13

Moses doesn't feel qualified to speak on behalf of God to Pharaoh

In addressing God as Adonai, Moses confesses that God runs the show

God's reply: He is the maker of our mouths

God doesn't always call the equipped But He always equips the called.

Gideon saw Adonai through his hidden seclusion

Bible text: Judges 6

Gideon responds by pouring his hesitancy into the cup of surrender

Judges 6:15 Oh my Adonai, wherewith shall I save Israel? Behold, my family is poor in Manasseh, and I am the least in my father's house.

God's response in verse 16: And the LORD said unto him, Surely I will be with thee, and thou shalt smith the Midianites as one man.

God must truly **own us**

Or we won't truly experience all of Him.

Adonai in the New Testament:

- Used of Jesus as *kurios (Greek) = Lord*
- Used more than 747 times
- In the book of Acts, Jesus is referred to as **Lord** 92 times
- He is referred to as **Savior** just twice

The Lordship of Jesus Christ means:

- Dominion
- Authority
- The right to rule over His creation
