1 Samuel 17: the story of David and Goliath

We all face our Goliaths

The Advantage of the Giant

Scripture: 1 Samuel 17:1-5

Background: The battle takes place in the valley of Elah. On the side of the Philistine army is the formidable Goliath; on the other, a young boy named David. A challenge is issued by Goliath (vs 8-9) which ignites fear in the Israelites. Fear paralyzes them.

If Goliath is standing before you,

YOU HAVE TO FACE HIM.

The Attitude toward the Giant

Scripture: 1 Samuel 17:25

Perspective – this is key in knowing and applying the character of God's names.

Vs. 25: The Israelites saw the same giant David saw, but they didn't see him the same way.

- Israelites looked at Goliath's size, strength and armor
- David look straight ahead, seeing who this giant really was
- David knew God and the power of His name

The Action toward the Giant

Scripture: 1 Samuel 17: 32-39

- A. David acted upon what he knew
 - a. He knew God had done miracles in the past
 - b. He knew God could do miracles now
- B. David acted on what he had
 - a. David had God's name it was enough to win the war

The names of God come with certain benefits and privileges.

USE THEM!

Vs 45b – "... but I come to thee in the name of the **Lord of hosts**."

"Lord of hosts" = Jehovah-Tsaba

JEHOVAH-TSABA: THE LORD OUR WARRIOR

David gave the battle over to God.

He had one truth in mind: Jehovah-Tsaba

Face your giants
In the name of Jehovah-Tsaba.
